Marianne Talbot BA., B.Phil, has been director of studies in philosophy at Oxford University's Department For Continuing Education since 2001. She is responsible for all the university's outreach in philosophy, including its very popular online short courses.

Two of Marianne's lectures have been made into podcasts which have reached global number one on iTunesU (the university of iTunes). 'A Romp Through the History of Philosophy' has been downloaded over 1 million times, and 'The Nature of Arguments' over 3 million times (see <http://itunes.ox.ac.uk>).
